| 2  | Sweatpants (not for hiking)                          | 1 | Sunscreen (no spray bottles)   |
| 2  | Fleeces or wool sweaters                             | 1 | Small backpack for around camp (important!)                                |
| 2  | Pairs of jeans/pants                                 | 1 | Flashlight/headlamp with batteries   |
| 2  | Swimsuits  |   | Writing paper/pen/envelopes, pre-addressed and stamped for younger campers |

**For Vespers/Dress-Up Occasions:**

- 2 Dress pants/shorts/skirt/dresses
- 2 Collared dress shirts
- 2 Ties (optional, except for 15-16 year olds who choose collared dress shirts)

Toiletries: Hairbrush, comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, anti-bacterial soap & soap container, nail file, nail clippers, shampoo/conditioner, hair ties, bathrobe (optional), shower tote (optional)

Horseback Riders: Riding boots, jodhpurs (optional), riding jacket (optional), riding helmet with chin strap (approved by U.S. Pony Club, Inc.), protective vest strongly recommended. Please let Brian know if your camper will need to borrow any items.

Optional Equipment: Camera, tennis racket, lax stick, fishing pole, fishing tackle, other sports equipment, daypack or frame pack, musical instrument, portable music player with earphones (**NO electronics with screen**), insect repellent (lotion only, <20% deet), reading material, etc.

Hikers: Backpack, sleeping bag, extra water bottle or equivalent.

Mountain Bikers: Mountain Bike (optional) and helmet

***No knives, firearms and /or archery bows are allowed to be brought to camp***  
**\*\*All articles must be marked with name tags or indelible ink.\*\***

Note: Laundry goes out once per week. There is a one day turnaround on clean clothing, so campers do not need a lot of extra clothing. *International campers do not need to bring bedding.*

Equipment such as riding boots & helmet, biking helmet, and other sports gear is available at camp for campers to use. It is not necessary to bring the equipment to play sports.
